VERY IMPORTANT MESSAGE Free School meals

The Government is giving money to schools to help children from lower income families to do their very best. This funding is called the 'pupil premium'. ***For every child registered as entitled to free school meals, Wilsden Primary School gets £430 this year.***

Please make sure that you claim before **Friday, 13th January**, to make sure that your child and others in our school don't miss out. Numbers of registered children are counted in our January Census.

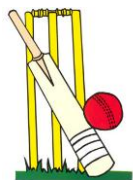
Village News

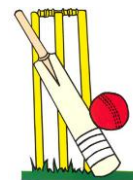


Wilsden Cricket Club Juniors
