This cost is around £2 per meal, but this would represent a big rise in the price all in one go. Therefore, on 7th January 2019, the price of a school meal will be £1.80 rising to £2.00 on Monday 29th April when the Summer term starts. 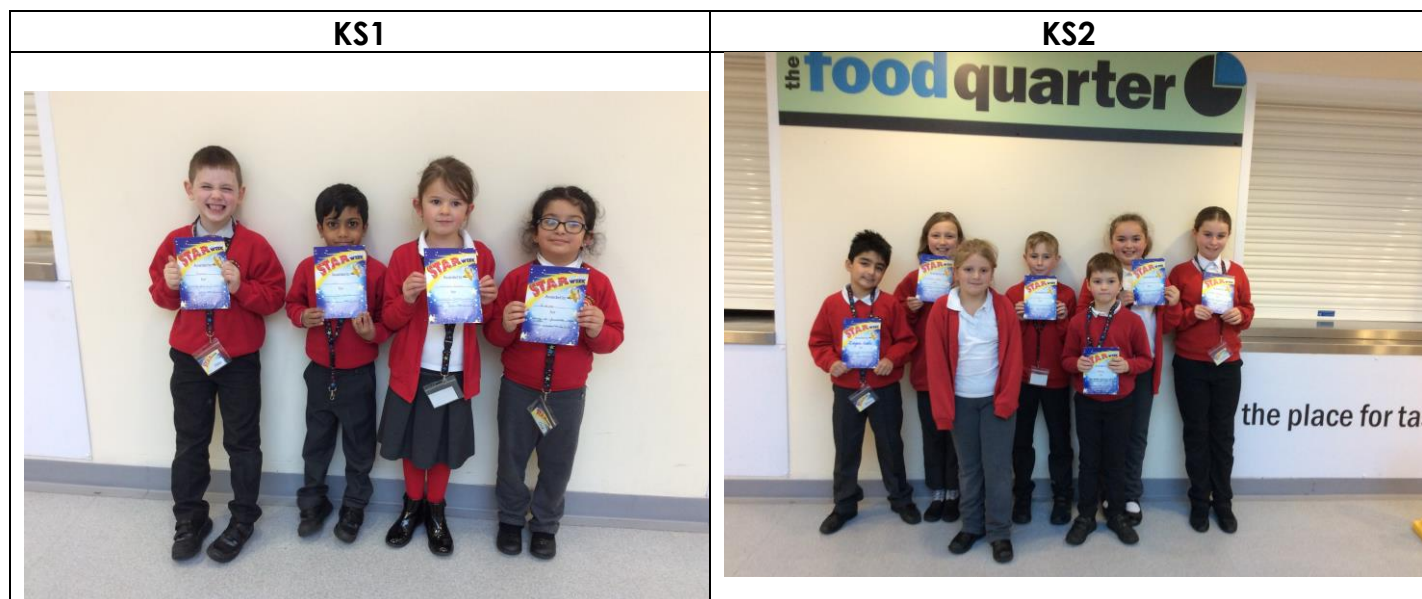
